♥ Access to Care ~ Medical Transportation:

To keep people healthy and in their homes, rides are provided by our volunteers to medical appointments once per week.

♥ Easing Hunger ~ Grocery Shopping:

To ensure food security and good nutrition, grocery shopping is provided once every two weeks.

♥ Respite to Caregivers of those with a chronic illness or dementia:

To provide relief to caregivers so they may take care of their own needs and have some time to themselves. Volunteers visit once per week.

♥ Joyful Companionship:

- ◆ **Caregiver Canines®**- To provide great tail-wagging joy, this program provides **in-home** volunteer and therapy dog visits.
- ◆ **Friendly Visits/Friendly Phone Calls**- To reduce isolation and loneliness.
- ◆ **Multicultural Outreach**- To enhance the visibility and accessibility of available services for seniors of diverse cultures. We have bilingual staff and volunteers.

- ◆ **Veteran to Veteran Program**- To honor our Veterans we match them with our Veteran Volunteers. Rides to VA Clinics and visits result in meaningful bonds of friendship.

- ◆ **CaregiverKids Program**- Valuable Aging Sensitivity Training is provided to school and youth groups followed by intergenerational programs which result in great happiness.
